

SMALL CREWS

Filming with small crews in Munich

In the case of film and photo shoots involving **little effort on public ground** (not public green spaces (e.g. Isar river banks), or areas of the Bavarian Palace Administration like e.g. the English Garden), no filming permit is required if all the following requirements are fully met:

Requirements

- use of pavements and pedestrian zones only (pedestrian traffic must be unhindered at all times)
- use of hand camera, shoulder camera only, max. one camera on tripod, microphone, boom and portable smaller hand lamps and reflectors
- no further aids or structures (such as camera drones, cable laying, generators, spotlights, chairs, cases etc.)
- no more than 5 persons (cast and crew on location) on public traffic ground involved in the shooting
- no scenes that contribute to endangering public safety and order (e.g. extremist, vio-lence-glorifying or pornographic films) or to impairing the public's sense of security (e.g. use of weapons, brawls, loud screams, threatening situations etc.)
- no filming in the areas of Viktualienmarkt, English Garden, Oktoberfest, metro and train stations and properties of the Bavarian Palace Department

Bigger sets and green spaces

Filming must be approved by the city administration if the requirements exceed the above-mentioned dimensions or the filming takes place on public green spaces. Applications for these areas must be submitted to the Film Service Office of the City of Munich.

Filming in moving traffic

Filming in moving traffic does not require a permit if the vehicles drive in accordance with the StVO and other traffic is not disturbed (e.g. car-to-car).
